Sun protection is recommended whenever UV levels reach 3 or higher. Check the UV for your location on the free SunSmart app or on the Bureau of Meteorology website.

Best steps for sun protection:

1. Slip on covering clothing
2. Slop on SPF 30 (or higher) broad-spectrum, water-resistant sunscreen.
3. Slap on a hat.
4. Seek shade
5. Slide on some sunglasses
